- July 12 & 14—Carve-out** Small caricature character w/Jim Girard & Larry Hanson. Sat. lunch will be leftover chicken from the picnic.

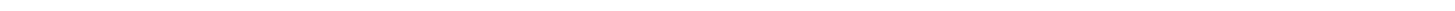
- July 13—Brewster Place** 1-3 pm
