Membership: 28 members

Treasurer's Report: Netlynx was paid \$265.54. Income was \$1,860.00 with a total of \$3630.97. Gary turned in a bill for \$59.87 for supplies he has been taking out of his pocket. Don moved to pay the bill and Wilbur seconded the motion.

Sheltered Living Tree: Gary bought a \$10.00 and a \$7.00 tree for use with the Sheltered Living tree for 2024 and 2025. The skirt for the tree is in the process of being made by Joetta. The tree has to be at Sheltered Living by the 21st of November instead of after the show as we thought originally.

Carve-outs: We will do bark carving on our own in December as we discuss the show.

Anyone interested in teaching at a carve-out let us know.

Seminars: John Engler will be back for painting seminar in on November 21 and 22 for painting our projects.

Warren Rauscher will again do a seminar for us on March 15th and 16th, 2025.

Food will be Pulled pork, chips, and drink for \$10.00. Hot Dog, chips, and drink for \$7.00. Pop: Coke, Dr. Pepper, 7 Up, and water. Cookies will also be available for purchase.

Gerald Copeland will be our judge this year and is doing it for free. We will let him have his table free in exchange.

We plan to **honor Carlan Honaker** with a special table at the show. Bring pictures and any of his carvings that you may have to display.

Any signs from last year need to have the dates changed to November 21 and 22.

We also have several basswood blocks of wood given to the club by Roy Berry and will be at the show on Sunday along with the wood previously given by Kathy Baker.
